








fig.56 Alphonse Bertillon, *Alphonse Bertillon*, 1891




fig.57 Alphonse Bertillon, *Georges Bertillon, brother of Alphonse*, 1892




fig.58 Alphonse Bertillon, *Mme Georges Bertillon*
