

Strategies for questions

- 1 **Talk within your knowledge**
- 2 **Buying time**
- 3 **Thinking out loud**

Buying time

- 1 Ask the question back.
- 2 Ask that the question be repeated.
- 3 Repeat the question yourself.
- 4 Just wait.

Thinking out loud

- **Be clear this is what you're doing.**
- **Pause a lot.**
- **Determine a path before you start.**
- **Say why you're unsure of steps.**

Asking Questions

- **Be humble and polite.**
- **Look at a single slide or pause to consider a single point.**
- **If you don't understand probably others don't either.**
- **Be prepared, read ahead of time!**
