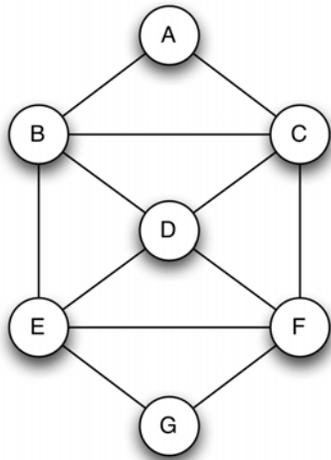


Problem Wk.13.3.2: Compare Searches
