- 1. What is the problem/need/hole?
- 2. Who is the audience?
- 3. What does the audience need to know to recognize the problem? Why?
- 4. What do I propose as a solution/objective?
- 5. What will the benefits be?
- 6. How will I accomplish my objectives?
- 7. How will I defend my approach?
- 8. Who will work on the solution?
- 9. What is the timetable?
- 10. What is the cost?
