

Current events is an ongoing weekly assignment. There are 2-3 students each week who must

1. Communicate with each other to select a current article relevant to K-12 education and come up with 3 guiding questions for the online discussion.
2. Email the article link and 3 questions to Jason Haas by Sunday night.
3. Lead a discussion (usually Thursday) that incorporates their own thoughts and those raised online.

Everyone else must read the article and respond to the questions in the Moodle forum for that article before the Thursday discussion.
